Introduction

The mission of Good Prospects Speech Pathology is to provide quality, evidence-based speech pathology services in areas of need or disadvantage in particular. Disadvantage is not always geographically specific. Good Prospects acknowledges the fact that Australia is and has been for some time a broadly diverse multi-cultural nation, yet health and education services in particular are not always as easily accessed by some culturally marginalised or linguistically challenged populations leading to poorer health and educational outcomes. This includes our own Indigenous populations as well demonstrated in current statistics. The resultant challenge for all professions involved in Australia's diverse population is therefore to consider how best these gaps can be narrowed.

Policy
