POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR SUPPORT

Positive Behaviour Support (PBS) is a therapy based service aiming to increase the wellbeing and quality of life for people with disabilities experiencing Behaviours of Concern.

Our practitioners work across the Adelaide and Barossa Valley regions, supporting clients in a variety of environments including school, home, work and in the community.

PBS is funded through the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS).

As per the NDIS Pricing Arrangements and Price Limits guide, PBS utilises the following NDIS funding lines:

- Capacity Building – Improved Relationships
- Capacity Building – Improved Daily Living.



SPEECH PATHOLOGY

Speech Pathology is a branch of allied health dedicated to developing and supporting communication in all its forms.

Speech Pathology builds skills & knowledge around:

- Language – the words that we understand and use, and the way we construct sentences
- Speech – the sounds we use to form words
- Voice – how we use body parts such as the larynx to make the sounds we need to communicate.
- Fluency – our speed and confidence in communicating
- Augmentative/Alternative Communication – also known by the acronym AAC, these include strategies and tools to supplement or replace spoken languages.

Stuttering occurs due to an interruption in speech production, and can involve the repetition of sounds or syllables, parts of words, whole words or phrases.

Cluttering affects someone's ability to convey messages clearly and concisely.

Our Speech Pathologists assist clients of all ages who need support with stuttering or cluttering.
